Detailed information	In Duart Blay they produce 8 types of onions to ensure supply in the vicinity areathroughout the year. The varieties are:
	- Spring (April, May and June).
	- Half Grain (June, July and August).
	- Grain (June to February).
	- Coldstode grain (March and April).
	<ul> <li>Sweet variety, red and white purple (all year round).</li> </ul>
	- Queen chat (from March to August).



Evidence of success	Punctual and periodic distribution with electric vans. In summer, they use the sameroute to supply watermelons, potatoes and garlic. This saves costs and helps to reduce the carbon footprint.
Challenges	As a product of proximity, costs are saved and markets can access all varieties of onions throughout the year. They are fresher products, they are harvested at the same time of ripening therefore, they have more nutrients. They are less perishablebecause they do not contain preservatives.
Potential for learning	Because emissions of polluting gases during transport are reduced and they are also more economical for the consumer because they are seasonal products. By reducing the carbon footprint, it respects the continuity of the biodiversity of our ecosystems.
